HYCOLE CONTINUES ITS DIVE INTO NEW TECHNOLOGIES

The genomic tool for resistance to EEL The VKE project





Two years ago, we presented the VKE project created in collaboration with Hungarian partners. The aim of this project is to **identify genes influencing resistance to EEL.**

The year 2019 and part of the year 2020, saw the second phase of the project come true: the breeding and phenotyping of almost 1,500 young rabbits of the white male line.

These phenotyping made it possible to determine areas of interest in the genome linked to resistance to EEL.


The project is ongoing and is currently challenging large groups of animals again in order to amplify and more precisely sequence these areas of interest. Hycole has sent more than 700 animals to continue in the progress of this project.


GIS Nord Sélection **Pooling for more selection power**



The Nord Selection Scientific Interest Group (GIS), created in 2015 in partnership with the pig breeding company Axiom, has brought together the R&D interests of the two companies and create new powerful tools, such as OCS (Optimum Contribution Selection).

On the strength of this first project, the GIS is now embarking on the creation of software for **the automatic analysis of ultrasound images.** Our objective is to have a suitable and powerful tool for both types of animals which will open up new prospects for selection on carcass criteria, such as yield, but also intramuscular fat.







OCS, an innovative tool

This work, carried out with the University Edinburgh Professor, Pong-Wong, is innovative because it first all makes it possible to manage consanguinity

manage consanguinity
continuously and no longer
afterwards but also and above all, to
manage it at the same time that the
genetic gain brought by each animal in a
population! This tool will therefore be used
to improve the annual genetic progress of
our populations and thus improve the farm
productivity using our genetics.

The OCS is therefore the first project of GIS Nord Selection and represents more than 3 years of work!



IN EUROPE, FOUNDATIONS ARE STRONG

Development in Hungary Hycole continues to invest!



We announced you last year a production potential increase for the **GP females** for the Italian market at our Hungarian sites. This year, we are continuing to develop our Hungarian center by **duplicating the White** *Male and GPC Male lines*.

A new building with 240 females of the White Male line and 220 of the C line was thus finalized at the start of 2020, in order to secure these lines which had until then only been present in our French center.

As with the D line, already present for more than 15 years in this subsidiary, these populations are totally linked to the French populations and managed by Hycole in France.



This development will massively increase the number of performances obtained yearly and to give Hycole an even stronger power of selection on his male lines.

In addition, the proximity between this new center and the slaughterhouse will make it possible to directly validate the results obtained on slaughter yield and notions of carcass qualities



In Italy, growth is continuing



At the same time, 2020 confirms our position on the market and the recognition of the genetic and sanitary quality of our breeders with a 45% increase in breeding animals delivered over the first 3 quarters of the year compared to 2019.

Since now more than 30 years, our investments and works in Research and Development have enabled the HYCOLE female® to continue her genetic evolution and perfectly meet today's production goals.

Selection is a long-term work that does not allow to always change to get better but to go deeper in order to do better.

The same goes for our male lines, whose semen volumes sold have increased by 53% with excellent results in terms of fertility, growth and yield.

We take advantage of this newsletter to thank the many customers and partners who have chosen to work with us in 2020 and in particular **Mr Da Rios** who testifies below to the ease of management of our female and his satisfaction in using our genetics.

Which brings us to the Americas and particularly the **United States** where Hycole rabbits now breed in **Texas!**




CONFIDENCE IS STILL THERE
